

Jeff Hunters Plan Divorce

Whitefish Bay Film Actor Is Parting From Barbara Rush

Film actress Barbara Rush and actor Jeffrey Hunter, who once was Henry H. McKinnies, Jr., of Whitefish Bay, are headed for a divorce, the Associated Press reported Wednesday.

The AP quoted Miss Rush: "We have been apart too much on our respective jobs."

As she was saying it, the couple parted again. Miss Rush headed to Ireland to go on location for "Captain Lightfoot"; Hunter to Mexico for "White Feather."

The couple was married Dec. 1, 1950 in Boulder City, Nev., and have a son, Christopher Merrill.

For 20 years Hunter, now 26, lived as Henry McKinnies with his parents in Whitefish Bay. His parents still live at 4957 N. Larkin St. He was graduated from Whitefish Bay High school and Northwestern University and studied a year at the University of California in Los Angeles. He signed a seven year contract in 1950 with 20th Century-Fox while he was a student at UCLA.

Mrs. McKinnies said she knew about the pending divorce but declined to comment on it.
