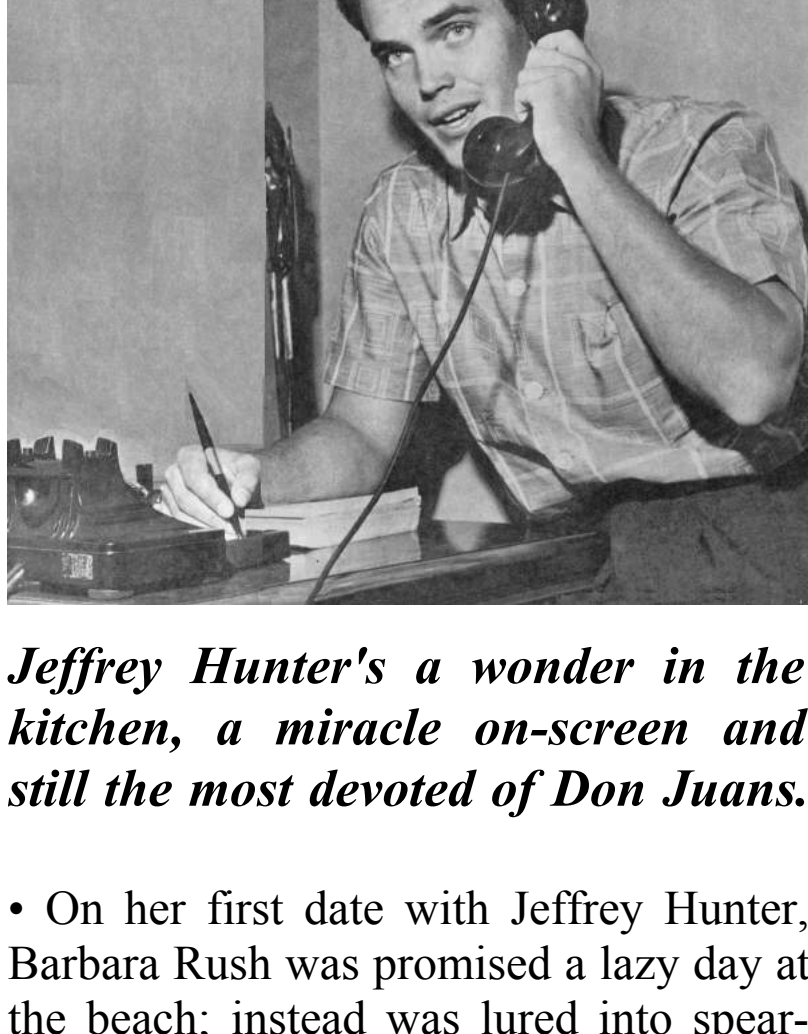

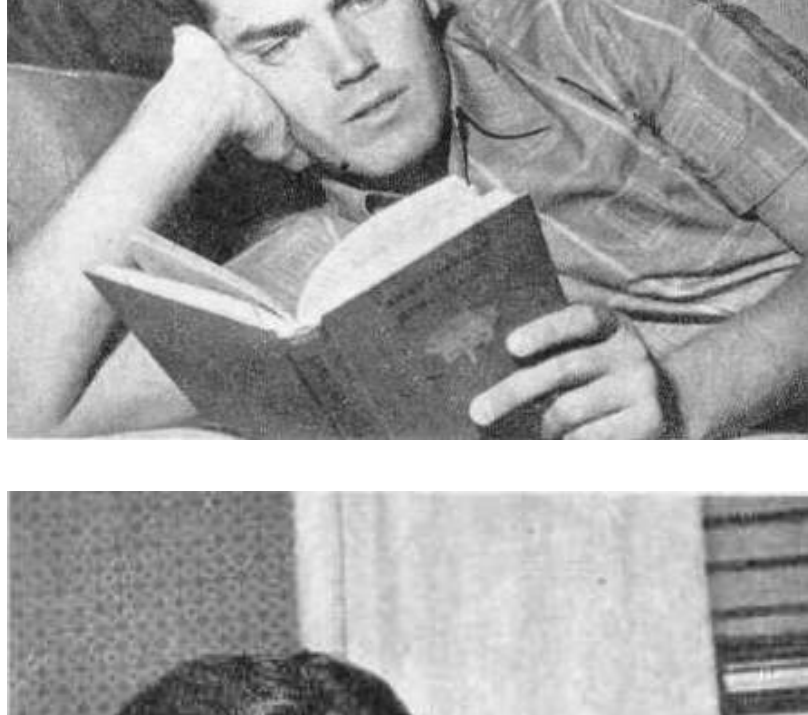


Jeffrey Hunter's a wonder in the kitchen, a miracle on-screen and still the most devoted of Don Juans.

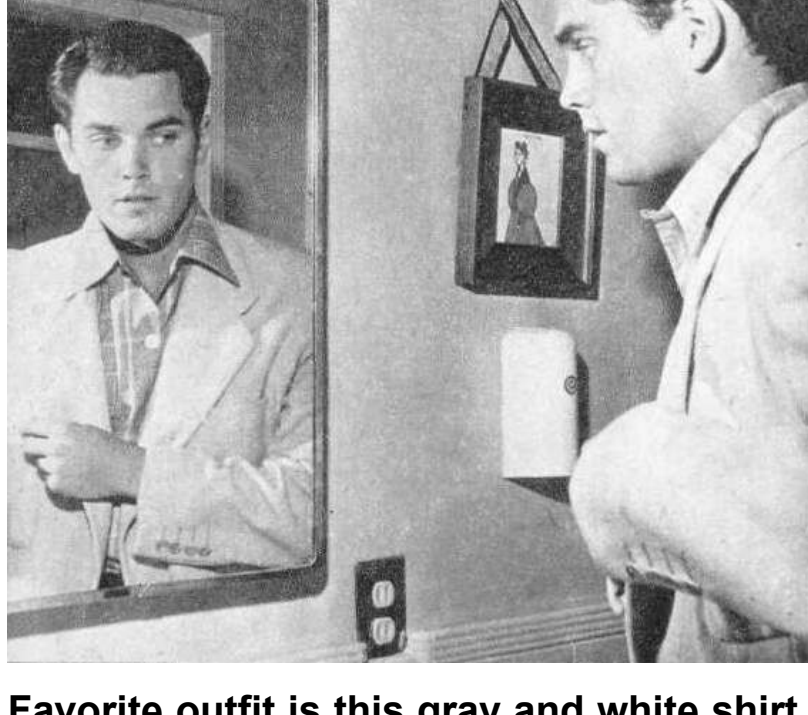
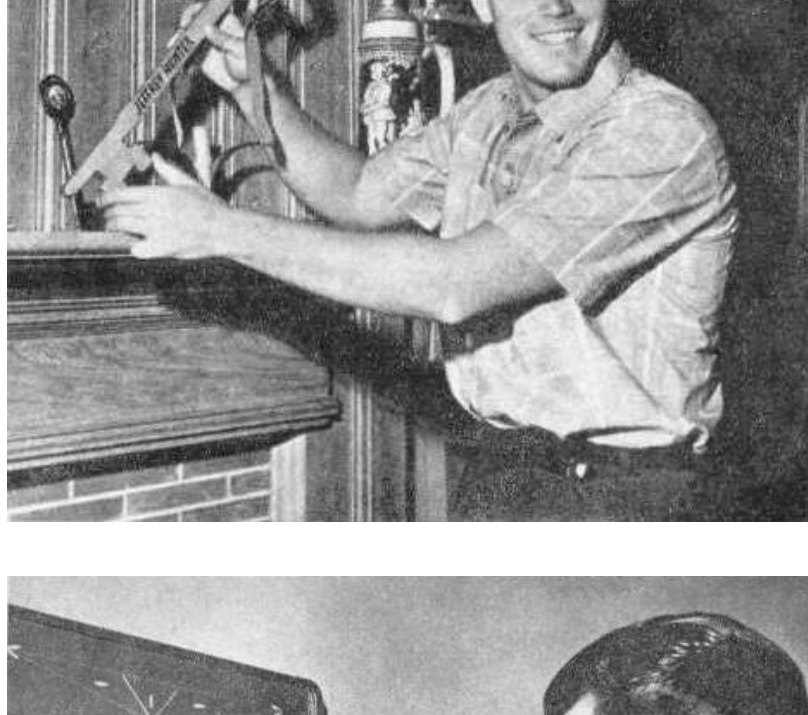

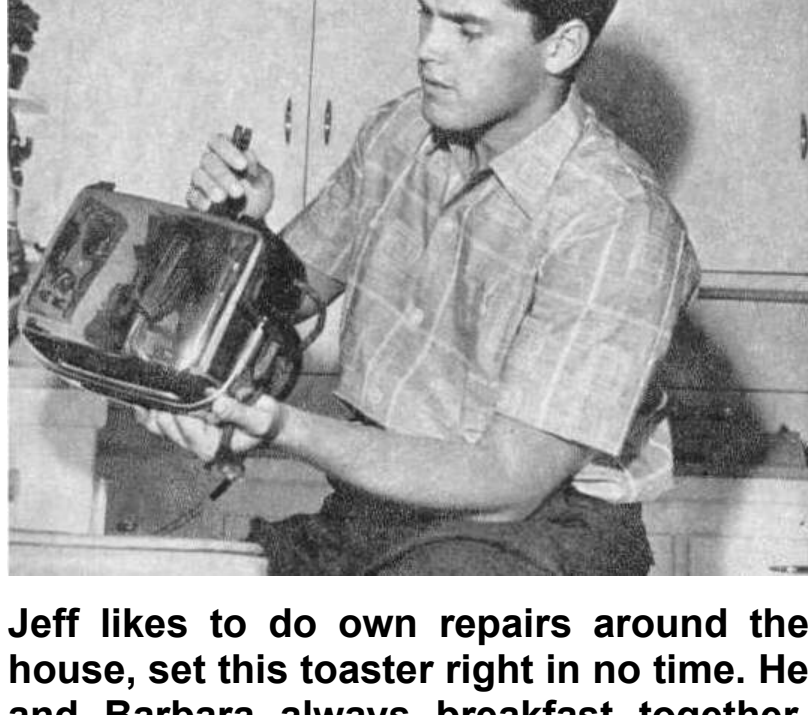
